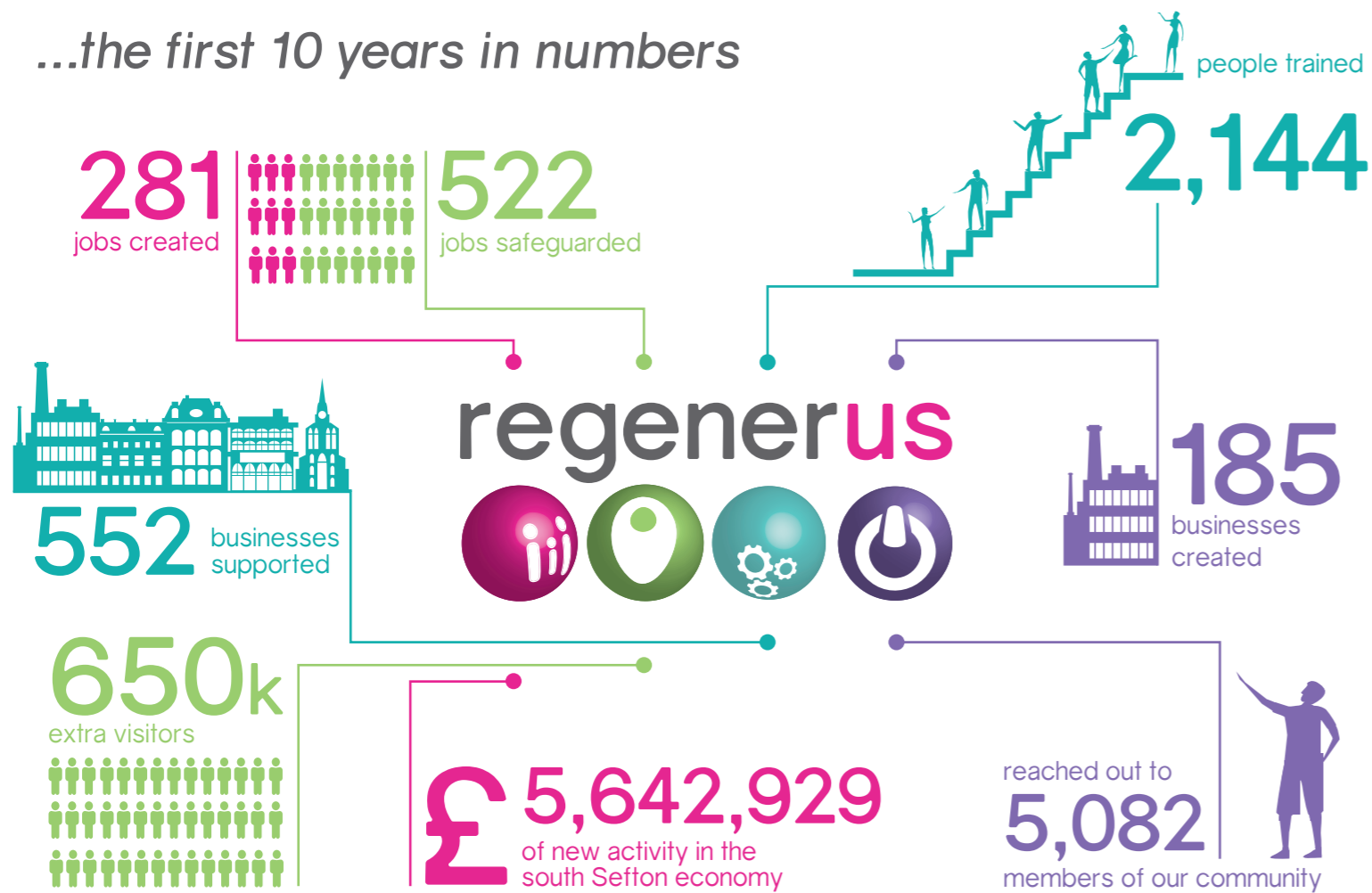

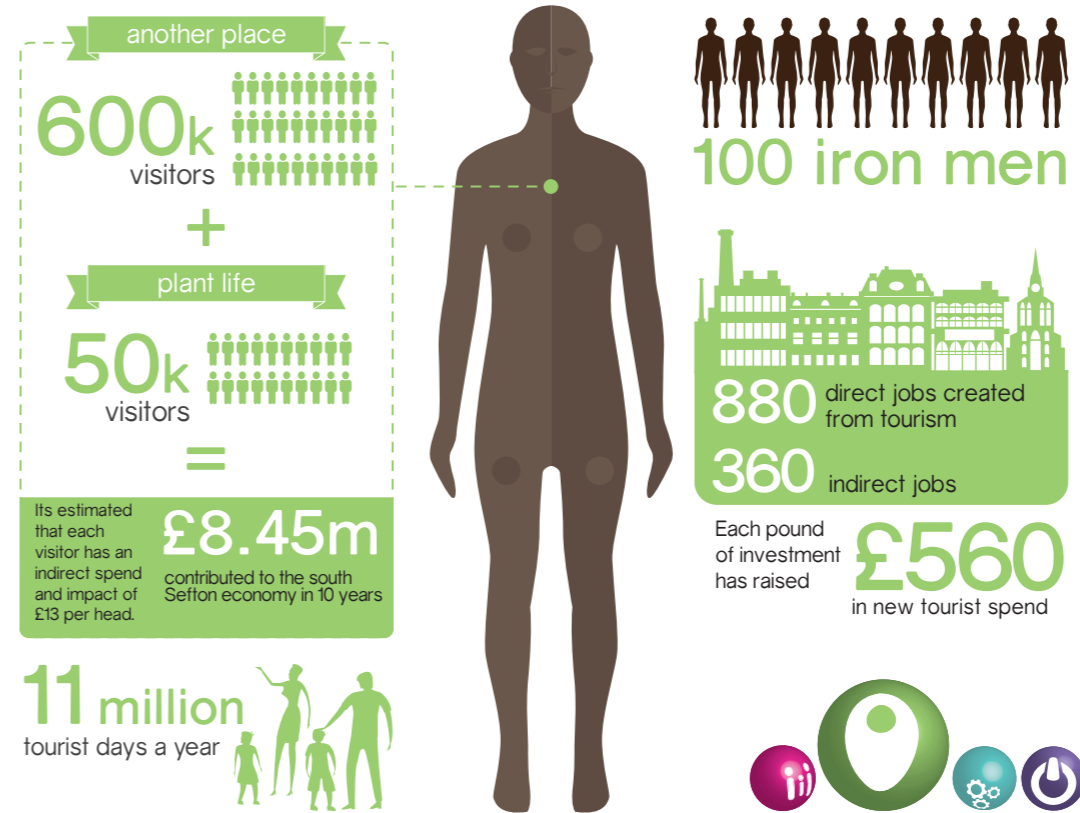

We pledge to continue to deliver and innovate our enterprise support.

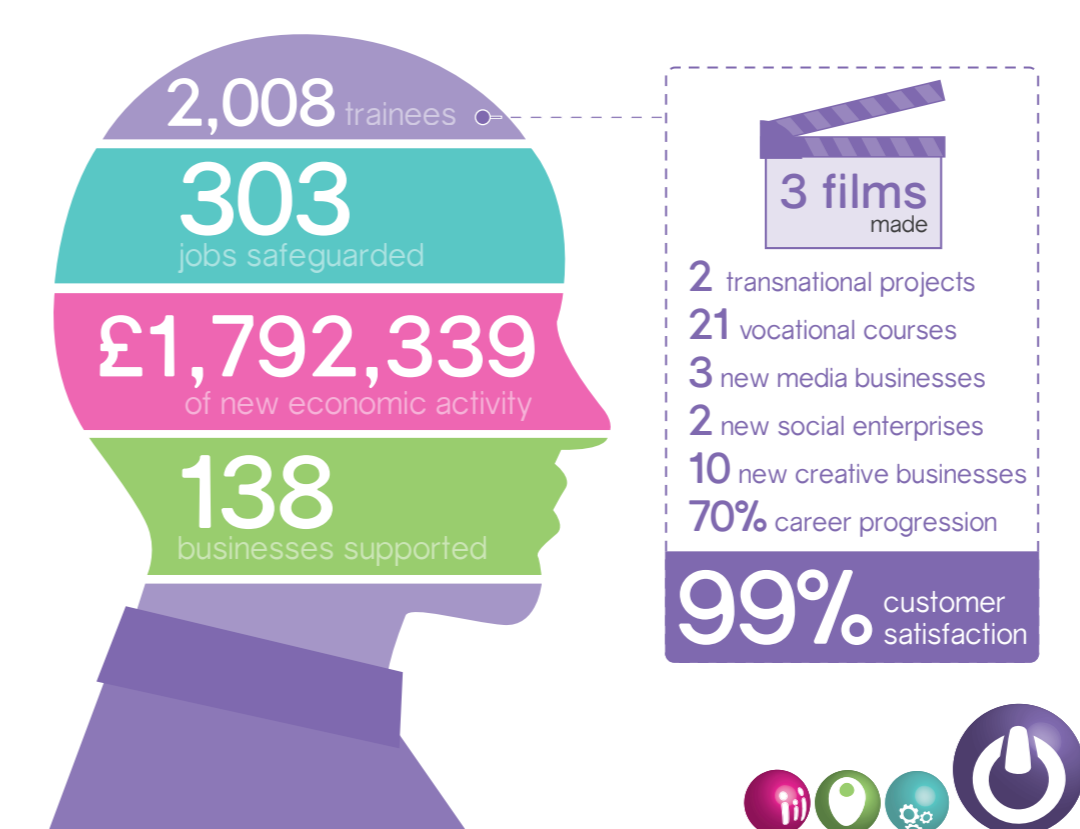
